

IBSCON 2026 – Abstract Submission Guidelines

General Instructions

- All presenting authors (oral or poster) **must be registered** for IBSCON 2026.
- All required fields in the online submission portal must be completed.
- Abstracts must be submitted **only by the presenting author**.
- Submission implies acceptance of all conference rules and policies.
- **Submission deadline: 15th July 2026**
- The selected presentation category (oral/poster) **cannot be changed later**.
- Abstracts must be **blinded** (no author names or institutional identity in the abstract text).
Blinding Instructions: Do not include within the abstract body text:
 - Author names
 - Institution names
 - Hospital identifiers
 - Acknowledgements
- Author and affiliation details should be entered only in the designated submission fields.
- The scientific committee will review and select abstracts for oral presentation.
- Abstracts not selected for oral presentation may be considered for **poster presentation**.
- Submitted abstracts may be published in the conference abstract book.
- You will need google account since it is submitted via google forms.

Abstract Submission Requirements

- Maximum submissions: **2 per presenting author**
Only one submission can be considered for oral presentation. [One oral/poster + one poster-only allowed]
- **Title:** Maximum 25 words, The abstract title should be in initial capital/lower case, not all capitals. The abstract title should be concise and describe/refer to the content.
- **Word limit:** Maximum 400 words
- **Structured format required:**
 - Introduction
 - Methods
 - Results
 - Conclusion

 One figure/table/image may be uploaded separately in JPG/PNG/PDF format.

Abstract exceeding 400 words may be rejected.

Submission Process

- Fill in the forms from the link provided
 - Registration details.
 - Presentation type:
 - Oral paper ((if not selected, may be considered for poster))
 - Poster only
 - Video presentation
 - Authors and presenting author separately. Authors' names should be supplied in capital/lower case, not all capitals.
 - Institutional affiliations should be indicated following the author name. Affiliation: All affiliations should contain institution, city and country
 - Presenter Photograph: A recent passport-size photograph of the presenting author must be uploaded during submission. Accepted formats: JPG/PNG. Maximum file size: 5 MB
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Abstract Categories (Indicative)

Authors should choose the most appropriate category:

- Gynecology
- Gastrointestinal
- Genitourinary
- Head and Neck
- Thoracic
- Hepatopancreatobiliary
- Skin
- Paediatric
- Innovative Brachytherapy Approaches
- Physics Synopsis
- Miscellaneous

Important Notes

- Incomplete submissions will be rejected.
- Late submissions will not be accepted.
- Presenters must adhere strictly to presentation time limits.
- Certificates will be issued only to **registered presenting authors**.
