

IBSCON 2026 – Video Abstract Submission Guidelines

1. General Requirements

- The video must present a scientific abstract clearly and concisely.
- Opening frame must include title, authors (presenting author first), and institution.
- Language (spoken and written) must be English.
- You will need google account since it is submitted via google forms.

2. Duration and Format

- Maximum duration: 5 minutes (recommended ≤ 4 minutes).
- Accepted formats: MP4 (preferred)
- Video must be well-edited and in HD quality.

3. Content Structure

Organize the video as:

1. Title Slide
 2. Background / Objective
 3. Materials and Methods
 4. Results
 5. Conclusion
- Slides, images, or animations must be embedded into the video.
 - Avoid distracting backgrounds or excessive animations.

4. Audio and Presentation

- Include clear audio narration (preferred) or background audio.
- Ensure clarity, proper synchronization, and good voice quality.

5. Technical Specifications

- Maintain a constant frame rate (≤ 60 FPS).
- Bit rate: 2,000 kb/s – 25,000 kb/s.
- Use readable text and high-resolution visuals.

6. File Naming and Submission

- File name format: VideoAbstract_PresenterName (e.g., VideoAbstract_RahulSharma.mp4).
- Submit via conference submission system/email (details to be announced).
- Ensure compatibility with standard Windows systems and keep a backup copy.
- A small writeup will also need to be submitted during the video submission.

7. Important Conditions

- No revisions allowed after submission deadline.
- Presenting author must be registered for the conference.
- Selected videos may be displayed and evaluated at the venue.

8. Evaluation and Presentation

- Judging based on scientific content, clarity, and audiovisual quality.
- Shortlisted candidates may have ~2 minutes Q&A.
- Judges' decision is final.

9. Additional Notes

- Avoid clutter, poor audio, and excessive animation.
- Ensure originality and ethical compliance.
